

<b>VARIETAL COMPOSITION</b>	100% Pinot Noir
<b>ORIGIN</b>	Funckenhausen Vineyards, San Rafael, Mendoza, Argentina. In selected vineyard plots, we carry out meticulous tasks such as shoot thinning, cluster thinning, and leaf removal, all aimed at maximizing the enological quality of the grapes.
<b>VINEYARDS</b>	Located in 25 de Mayo, San Rafael, at an altitude of 850 meters above sea level, this area features a semi-desert climate with a very high diurnal temperature range. The soils are loamy-sandy of alluvial origin, with the presence of pebbles and caliche. Irrigation is carried out via drip systems using water sourced from the Diamante River, which is fed by snowmelt from the Andes Mountains. The abundant sunny days, constant winds, and well-drained soils enable us to maintain healthy vineyards capable of producing high-quality grapes. These are harvested at their optimal ripeness to reflect the unique characteristics of the terroir. Yields average approximately 6,000 kg/ha.
<b>HARVESTING</b>	Manual in 16 kg. cases. Second half of February
<b>WINEMAKING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Cluster selection, destemming, and crushing.</li><li>-Pre-fermentative cold maceration in stainless steel tanks with the addition of dry ice.</li><li>-Fermentation: conducted in stainless steel tanks at controlled temperatures below 23°C with selected yeasts.</li><li>-Maceration period: approximately 28 days.</li><li>-Malolactic fermentation: spontaneous.</li><li>-Barrel aging: 9 months in 225-liter French oak barrels.</li><li>-Cold stabilization, light filtration, and bottling.</li></ul>

<b>TASTING NOTES</b>	It exhibits a bright, light reddish color. The nose presents aromas of red fruits, strawberry, currants, subtly complemented by notes from its time in oak. On the palate it has a pleasant entry, with medium body and a refreshing and elegant finish that perfectly reflects the varietal character and its place of origin. Excellent with poultry such as chicken or duck, semi-hard cheeses, pasta and even steamed or grilled fish.
